

- 1. REMOVE 7/16 ACORN NUT FROM SAFTY PIN
- 2. REMOVE SAFTY PIN FROM THE NOSE
- 3. **WARNING:** REINSTALL SAFTY PIN IN ARM LOCKING HOLE PRIOR TO PERFORMING THIS PROCEDURE
- 4. LIFT NOSE COVER

- 5. SLIDE CONNECTOR COVER BACK AND DISCONNECT CABLE
- 6. REMOVE NUT USING 7/16 WRENCH, AND DISCARD
- 7. REMOVE RETAINING PLATE, AND DISCARD
- 8. SLIDE THE P-9 STRAIGHT FORWARD

INSTALLING THE P-10

PROCEDURE

- 1. REMOVE ALLEN HEAD CAP SCREW FROM THE NOSE USING A 3/16 ALLEN WRENCH, AND DISCARD
- 2. SLIDE THE P-10 INTO PLACE
- 3. LINE UP THE HOLE IN THE PLATE WITH THE THREADEDED HOLE IN THE NOSE




- 4. REMOVE SCREW FROM THE CLIP
- 5. INSERT AND TIGHTEN THE SCREW USING A 3/16 ALLEN WRENCH
- 6. RECONNECT CABLE AND TIGHTEN WITH (2) 7/16 WRENCHES
