#### INTRODUCTION


This document provides the information to install the Bella A-Series Module, **PD295-005**, to a PDi A-Series Large Screen Healthcare TV.

#### **BILL OF MATERIALS**

P/N	Description	QTY
PD295-005	Bella A-Series Module	1
PD106-981	26pin to RJ45 Cable, for Power & CCI	1
PD106-977	HDMI Cable	1

#### **INSTALLATION**

- 1. Determine a clean, flat location where you want to mount the module, **PD295-005**, on the back of the PDi TV. Note: Ensure the cables included can reach the appropriate locations on the PDi TV.
- 2. Using a PDi approved cleaning solution, clean the location on the PDi TV where you will mount the module, **PD295-005**, and allow the area to dry. Note: Not following this step may lead to the VHB not adhering to the back of the PDi TV. See **PDTCHB31**, Disinfecting PDi Hospital Grade Televisions Safely, for approved cleaning methods.
- 3. Remove the adhesive backing from the VHB on the back of the module, **PD295-005**, and attach it to the back of the PDi TV. Note: For the best performance of the VHB adhesive, orient the module, **PD295-005**, in one of the two options shown below.



- 4. Connect the cables as described in the graphic below.
  - a. Note: HDMI1 is the default setting but can be changed in the Bella-HD setup menus. See installation document for the Bella-HD unit, PD196-426, on the PDi website for details on changing that setting. Note: if using this unit with a new A-Series TV, the TV comes with all HDMI sources disabled. See the A-Series User Manual, PD196-389, for how to enable the HDMI source.



#### **TROUBLESHOOTING**

- 1. The red LED shown indicates that the unit is receiving power. For the unit to receive power, the unit must be connected to the A-Series TV and the TV must be powered on.
- 2. On the CAT connector to the TV, neither LED will light up.
- 3. On the CAT connector to the Bella-HD unit, the yellow light indicates there is a connection. The green light indicates an HDMI signal is being received by the unit.
- 4. If the unit is not changing channels, ensure that the switch is in the position closest to the RJ45 connector.
